Bogor Golf Package 7D/6N/4G

Bogor is located some 45 minutes south of Jakarta's city center and is the gateway to The Puncak (The Peak), a popular weekend mountain retreat for Jakarta people and once the cradle of the Dutch East Indies tea culture. Even today, many of the former Dutch tea plantations are still in operation while one of the oldest tea factories in the country can be visited on any given day.

INDOGOLF TRAVEL INFORMATION SHEET

In the Bogor and pre-Puncak highlands of Sentul, as many as 10 golf courses can be played. All of these courses are located within half an hour (30 min.) from each other. Right at the very heart of Bogor we'll find Novotel Bogor, a beautiful 5 star hotel. It is set amongst breathtaking gardens and features an 18 hole golf course, 178 rooms (including suites), conferencing and banqueting facilities, WiFi Internet access, two restaurants, a bar, Spa, swimming pool, tennis courts and Kids Club. This magnificent hotel is designed to satisfy every need and expectation and is your home away from home for this attractive golf package.

7-DAY JAKARTA/BOGOR WEEKDAY GOLF PACKAGE (7D/6N/4G)

Day 1 Sunday: Arrival on a Sunday at Jakarta airport followed by transfer to Novotel Bogor



Day 2 Monday: After breakfast tee off at Club Golf Bogor Raya right next door to Novotel Bogor



ABOUT THE COURSE: (Members & Guests)

As it is home to some 8 fantastic courses, the Bogor region is often called the Mecca of Indonesian golf. Klub Golf Bogor Raya (KGBR) is located right in the very heart of it. This Graham Marsh designed course is set amidst the 400-hectare integrated resort development of Bogor Lake Side and offers a friendly but challenging game to players of all levels of skill. With a choice from 4 tee box positions, the black is the toughest. The KGBR layout is a testament to what golf in Indonesia is all about: a quality facility. The friendly layout is wide and receptive of wayward shots at the opening holes, but becomes more narrow and tricky on the back nine. Through excellent maintenance and attention to detail the course gradually has been transformed into a genuine tropical garden and a feast for the eye. Here golf is played in absolute tranquility amidst panoramic views and mountain backdrops.

Day 3 Tuesday: After breakfast tee off at Sentul Highlands Golf Club



ABOUT THE COURSE: (Members & Guests)

Officially opened in May 1997 under the name Padang Golf Satelindo, Sentul Highlands Golf Club has gone through many name changes. The course is designed by Gary Player and is situated in the prestigious fully integrated Royal Sentul Highlands housing estate. The front nine snakes through the rather cultivated and residential part of the site where housing is a predominant feature, while the back nine is located in the more rural and more agricultural part of the Sentul highlands. Although the back nine is shorter than the front nine, it definitely is the more difficult part of the layout. Especially the uphill par 5 holes #11 and #17 stand out and need to be played wisely. Here, shot making and placing is important. Low handicappers should try and play the awesome black tee. Sentul Highlands Golf Club offers a three-hole practice layout (one par 3 and two par 4 holes) for beginners and juniors, as well as a practice putting green and a fully equipped driving range.

Day 4 : After breakfast we embark on a full day discovery trip to the Puncak tea plantations and Bogor's famous Botanical Gardens.



Day 5 Thursday: After breakfast tee off at Gunung Geulis West Course



ABOUT THE COURSE: (Members & Guests)

In the Sundanese (West Javanese) language Gunung Geulis means "Beautiful Mountain". Some 500 meter above sea-level, this majestic mountain-side golf resort offers two 18-holes courses of which the oldest is the West Course (1992).

Standing on the ever impressive opening hole, one has a bird's eye view on the valley from which Thomson & Wolveridge carved out this boulder- and rock-rich layout.

From tee box 1 - most likely one of Asia's most impressive opening holes - your tee shot plunges a solid 60 meters onto a fairly narrow fairway dotted with 3 intimidating bunkers to the right and an OB area on the left. Club selection is important. The long and winding cart path takes you to the fairway for your second shot.

This opening hole will surely determine the player's attitude on the remainder of this impressive course. The par 5 holes #6, #9 and #12 are long and amongst the most difficult holes on the course.

Playing at Gunung Geulis is an exciting experience in itself as the environment in which it is placed is typical of the natural beauty found in Indonesia.

Day 6 Friday: After breakfast tee off at Rainbow Hills Golf Club



ABOUT THE COURSE: (Members & Guests)

Rainbow Hills is located in a truly magnificent and dramatic part of the highlands that lead up to the mountain resort of the Puncak (Peak), surely the most favorite of weekend retreats for Jakarta people.

Designed by J. Michael Poellot Golf Design Group (JMP), the course takes full advantage of a picturesque setting, carefully sculpting the abundant natural gifts of the site into a spectacular golf landscape. At Rainbow Hills golfers will enjoy astonishing visual drama.

To create an exciting series of 18 holes, each fairway is carefully sculptured into the site, each distinctly different from the others. For all the right reasons, the par 5 hole #13 is the signature hole. Standing at the top of the hole, your tee shot drops a hefty 100 to 130 meters onto a downhill fairway.

A well placed second shot will give you a shot into the well protected green that is positioned on the left and over water (see picture).

Finesse and accuracy will be rewarded, for this course encourages initiative and well-placed shots. No matter what your score card reads, as you stroll from the final green you will take with you a sense of pride, satisfaction and accomplishment, eagerly looking forward to your next chance to play Rainbow Hill.

Day 7 Saturday: After breakfast free at own leisure followed by check out and transfer to Jakarta Int. airport.
